Cancellation: Cancellation of the competitor entry, if any, has to be done latest until **1st of April 2026**.

For any late cancellation after 1st of April 2026, or no-show at the competition, entry fee will not be returned.

Prizes: Competitors placed 1st to 3rd will be awarded with medals and diplomas other competitors with diplomas.

The music files must be sent as MP3 file format. Any other format is not acceptable. The Organizing Committee is not responsible if the quality of the music sent would be insufficient. Each Competitor must have their own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of a MP3 file. The exact running time of the music (not skating time) must be communicated to the Organizing Committee when submitting the music and shall be certified by the Competitor/Coach/Team Leader at the time of registration.

Calculations of the results: The ISU Judging System will be used.

Draw: Electronic drawing of the start numbers will be performed in the presence of the referee until 18:00 two days prior to the competition.

Judges and technical panel:

The panel of judges and Technical panel will be formed by OC and will include judges from the participating countries if possible. Panel of Judges must be approved by Croatian Figure Skating Federation and will be confirmed to participating country one week after the deadline. OC covers the accommodation expenses and travel expenses only for the invited judges, referees nominated TC I TS if they are traveling from other members.

- Basic Novice II Girls, born from 1. 7. 2013 – 30. 6. 2014.
- Basic Novice III Girls, born from 1. 7. 2014 and younger.

- CUBS I. Girls: born from 1. 7. 2015 – 30. 6. 2016.

Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

CHICKS Boys and Girls: born from 1. 7. 2017 – and younger

Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

A well balanced Free Skating program for CUBS Boys and Girls must contain:

a) Maximum of 4 jumps elements one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or one (1) jump combination and one (1) jump sequence. Jump combinations and the jump sequence consist of two (2) jumps. In the jump sequence the second jump must be an Axel type jump with a direct step from the landing curve of the first jump in to the take-off curve of the Axel jump. One full revolution on the ice between the jumps (free foot can touch the ice, but without weight transfer) keeps the element in the frame of the definition of a jump sequence. Jumps executed in a jump sequence receive their full value. No triple and quadruple jumps are allowed. Only one single jump and one double jump (including Double Axel) can be repeated once.

b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination and one must be a spin with no change of position and no change of foot. The spin combination with a change of foot must have a minimum of eight (8) revolutions and without a change of foot with a minimum of six (6) revolutions. Flying entry is allowed. If with change of foot, only one level feature per foot will count. The spin in one position without change of foot must have a minimum of six (6) revolutions, must be done in a basic position. No level features are allowed in this spin. 8 revolutions can be done but will not count as an attempted feature. Flying entry is not allowed.

c) There must be a maximum of one (1) step sequence fully utilizing the ice surface and must include at least one skating movement such as a spiral, spread eagle, Ina Bauer, hydroblading etc. If the skating movement is missing, no Level will be given. The Technical Panel will not award Feature 3) Use of body movements for at least 1/3 of the pattern and Feature 4) Two combinations of 3 difficult turns on different feet.

Levels explanations:

For Cubs Singles, in all elements that are subject to Levels, only features up to Level 2 will be counted.

Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

A well balanced Free Skating program for CHICKS Boys and Girls must contain:

- a) Maximum of 4 jump elements one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or one (1) jump combination and one (1) jump sequence. Jump combinations and the jump sequence consist of two (2) jumps. In the jump sequence the second jump must be an Axel type jump with a direct step from the landing curve of the first jump in to the take-off curve of the Axel jump. One full revolution on the ice between the jumps (free foot can touch the ice, but without weight transfer) keeps the element in the frame of the definition of a jump sequence. Jumps executed in a jump sequence receive their full value. No triple and quadruple jumps are allowed. Only one single jump and one double jump (including Double Axel) can be repeated once.
- b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination and one must be a spin with no change of position and no change of foot. The spin combination with a change of foot must have a minimum of eight (8) revolutions and without a change of foot with a minimum of six (6) revolutions. Flying entry is allowed. If with change of foot, only one level feature per foot will count. The spin in one position without change of foot must have a minimum of six (6) revolutions, must be done in a basic position. No level features are allowed in this spin. 8 revolutions can be done but will not count as an attempted feature. Flying entry is not allowed.
- c) There must be a maximum of one (1) step sequence fully utilizing the ice surface and must include at least one skating movement such as a spiral, spread eagle, Ina Bauer, hydroblading etc. If the skating movement is missing, no Level will be given. The Technical Panel will not award Feature 3) Use of body movements for at least 1/3 of the pattern and Feature 4) Two combinations of 3 difficult turns on different feet.

Levels explanations:

For Chicks Singles, in all elements that are subject to Levels, only features up to Level 2 will be counted.

Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

OTHER CATEGORIES

TEENAGERS competitors who have not reached the age of 18 by July 1st before the start of the competition

Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

1. The program can contain a maximum of 5 (five) single jumps, only one combination is allowed, any jump can be repeated only once in a combination.
2. A maximum of three (3) different spins. Number of turns in spins: minimum 5 for spins without a change of foot, and 8 for spins with a change of foot.
3. A maximum of one step sequence (StSq) or a choreographic sequence that fully utilizes the ice surface which will be evaluated only in GOE. Only the first performed attempt of a series of steps will be included in the technical assessment.

The use of props that do not damage the ice and that skater can bring and take off the ice is permitted. Skaters will be evaluated in 3 components according to the ISU rules. If skater does not perform a single spin or jump, the chief judge will apply a deduction of -0.5 points for each of these two elements, the same deduction will be applied for each over-numbered jump. A fall is deducted - 0.5 points The factor for the components is 1.67.

In case of large number of participants OC may divide the skaters by age.

ADULT

Age limits and technical requirements for adults are prescribed by the ISU regulations for international adult competitions IAFSC Technical Requirements for ISU Supported Adult Figure Skating Competitions.

In the case of applying for the competition in two categories, the registration fee is 50 EURO per category.
